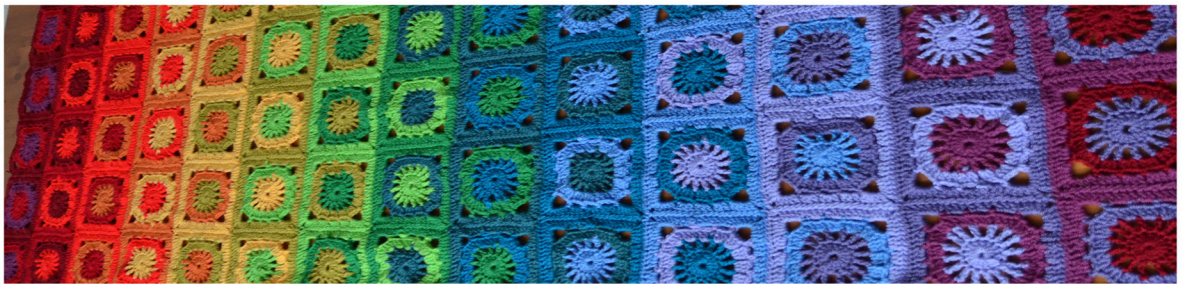

ENGLISH PATTERN



YOU NEED:

- * 5 MM HOOK
- * 14 BALLS OF YARN +/- 300 M A PIECE
- * TAPESTRY NEEDLE
- * SCIZZORS

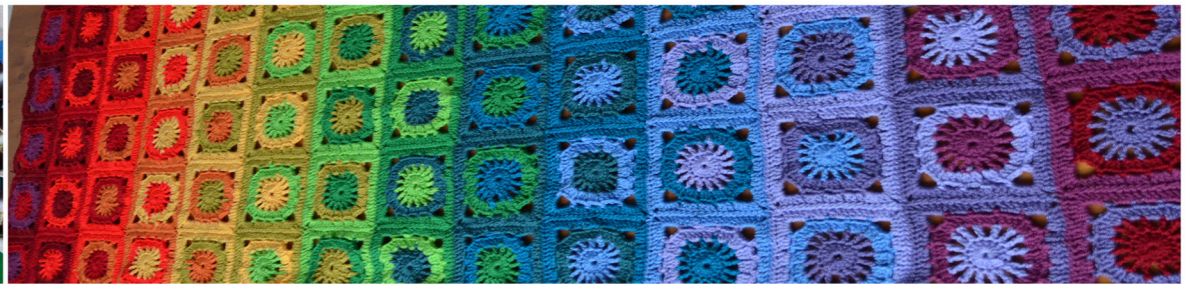
STITCHES YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFOREHAND:

- * CHAINS (CH)
- * SLIP STITCHES (SL ST)
- * SINGLE CROCHET (SC)
- * DOUBLE CROCHET (DC)
- * MAGIC RING

YOUTUBE HAS A DATABASE WITH THE MOST MAGNIFICENT MOVIES TO LEARN THESE STITCHES. IF YOU DON'T KNOW THEM YET, TAKE A LOOK AND LEARN THEM BEFORE YOU START.

- * DIMENSIONS OF THE BLANKET (IF YOU CROCHET WITH 5MM HOOK) WILL BE AROUND 140x180 CM, BUT THIS CAN DIFFER WHEN YOU CROCHET LOOSE OR VERY TIGHT. A SQUARE SHOULD BE AROUND 11 OR 12 CM WIDE. USE A LARGER OR SMALLER HOOK WHEN IT IS SMALLER OR LARGER THAN THAT.
- * IF YOU USE OTHER COLOURS THAN THE ONES ADVISED, CHOOSE 14 OTHER COLORS THAT WILL MATCH BEAUTIFULLY WITH THIS PATTERN.
LAY THE COLOURS IN ORDER AND WRITE THEM DOWN ON THE DOTTED LINES ON THE NEXT PAGE. THIS WAY THEY WILL BE ASSIGNED TO A NUMBER. IN THE PATTERN I WILL REFER TO NUMBERS INSTEAD OF COLOURS TO PREVENT ANY CONFUSION. THE NEXT PAGE IS VERY IMPORTANT AND WILL BE USED OFTEN. THE KEY OF THIS BLANKET IS THE CAREFULLY THOUGHT OUT PATTERN OF THE COLOURCHANGES.

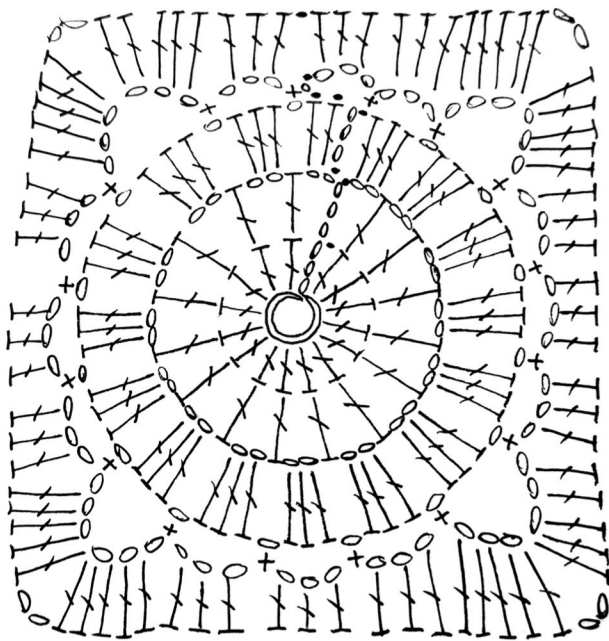
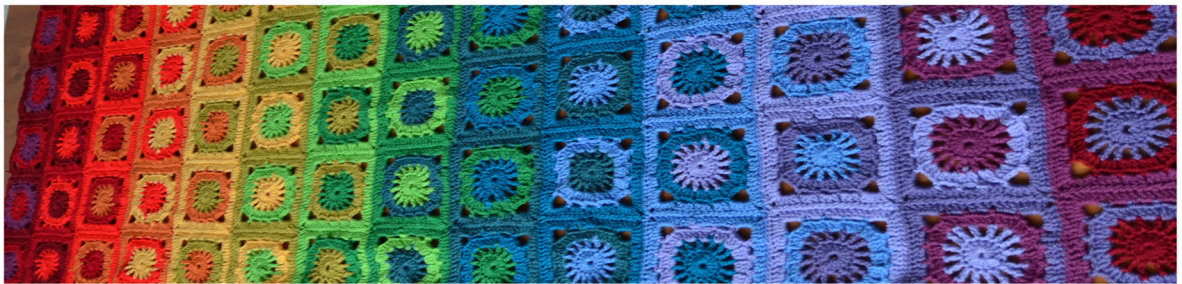

ENJOY THIS CHEERFUL PATTERN!



MAKE A MAGIC RING OR CH 6 TO FORM RING.



R1: CH 3 IN RING (= 1DC), 15 DC IN RING AND FINISH WITH SL ST IN 3RD CH FROM BEG. OR ROUND (= 16DC)



R2: CH 5 (1DC + 2CH), *1 DC IN NEXT DC, CH2* REPEAT FROM * TO * UNTIL END OF ROUND. FINISH WITH SL ST IN 3RD CH. (=16DC WITH 2CH BETWEEN EACH).

SWITCH COLOUR



R3: 1SL ST IN FIRST CH SPACE, CH3 (=1DC), 2DC IN SAME CH SPACE, *CH1, 3DC IN NEXT CH SPACE* REPEAT UNTIL END OF ROUND. FINISH WITH 1 CH AND 1 SL ST IN 3RD CH.



R4: 1 SL ST IN EACH OF THE FIRST 2DC, CH1, 1SC AROUND FIRST CH (FROM PREVIOUS ROUND), *CH3, 1SC AROUND NEXT CH, CH6, 1SC AROUND NEXT CH, CH3, 1SC AROUND NEXT CH, CH3, 1SC AROUND NEXT CH* REPEAT A TOTAL OF 4 TIMES, BUT FINISH WITH 1 SL ST IN SC FROM BEG. OF ROUND (INSTEAD OF AROUND NEXT CH).



SWITCH COLOUR



R5: 1 SL ST AROUND FIRST 3-CH SPACE, CH3 (=1DC), 2DC IN THE SAME CH SPACE, THEN 5DC + 2CH + 5 DC IN EACH 6-CH SPACE (=CORNER), AND 3 DC IN EACH CH3 SPACE TO END. FINISH WITH 1 SL ST IN 3RD CH FROM BEG. OF ROUND. CUT AND FASTEN THREAD, WEAVE IN BACK OF GRANNY SQUARE.

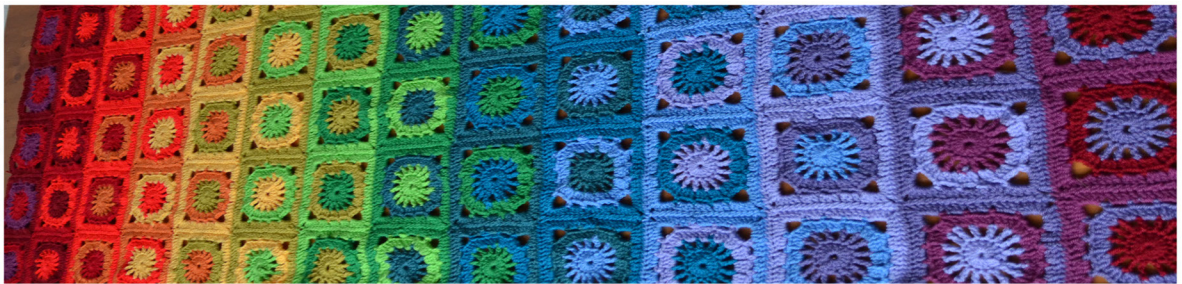
ATTACHING THE SQUARES

WHEN YOU FINISH A ROW WITH 10 SQUARES, YOU CAN ALREADY ATTACH THEM. IT'S MORE FUN TO DO THIS IN BETWEEN ROWS INSTEAD OF AT THE END. THAT WAY YOU'LL SEE YOUR BLANKET GROW WITH EACH ROW. YOU CAN DO THIS 3 DIFFERENT WAYS:

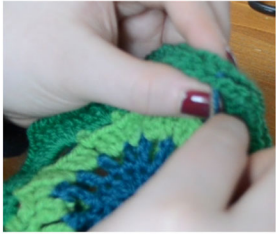
*SEW THEM TOGETHER WITH NEEDLE AND YARN

*CROCHET THEM TOGETHER USING SLIP STITCHES.

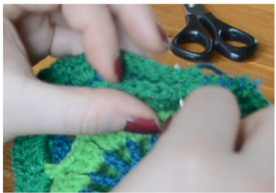
I HIGHLY RECOMMEND TO DO THIS WITH NEEDLE AND YARN, BECAUSE IT'S THE LEAST VISIBLE WAY. ALSO THE BLANKET WILL STAY NICE AND FLAT THIS WAY OPPOSED TO WHEN YOU CROCHET THEM TOGETHER. I'LL ILLUSTRATE THE SEWING TECHNIQUE ON THE NEXT PAGE.



ATTACHING THE SQUARES



USE A TAPESTRY NEEDLE THAT FITS THE YARN.
PUT THE TWO SQUARES WITH THEIR BACKS AGAINST EACH-
OTHER.
TAKE THE CORNERS AND ATTACH THE YARN IN AN INVIS-
IBLE WAY IN THE CORNER.

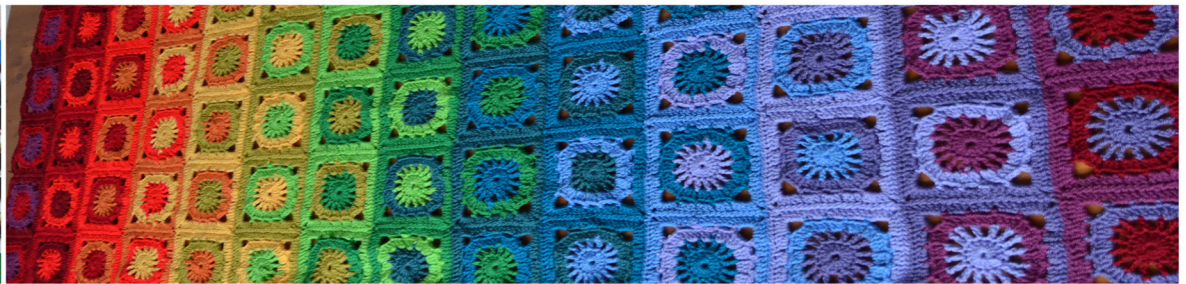


TURN THE SQUARES IN SUCH WAY THAT YOU CAN SEE THE
'V'-S AT THE TOP OF THE STITCHES. ALIGN THE STITCH-
ES AS BEST AS POSSIBLE. UNDERNEATCH THOSE STITCHES
PULL THE YARN WITH THE NEEDLE AND PULL NOT TOO
TIGHT.



UNFOLD THE SQUARES AGAIN, LAY THEM FLAT AND PULL
THE NEEDLE THROUGH THE BACK SEAM OF YOUR RECENTLY
SEWN STITCHES. MAKE A KNOT, PULL THE NEEDLE FURTHER
THROUGH THE SEAM TO WEAVE IN AND CUT THE YARN.

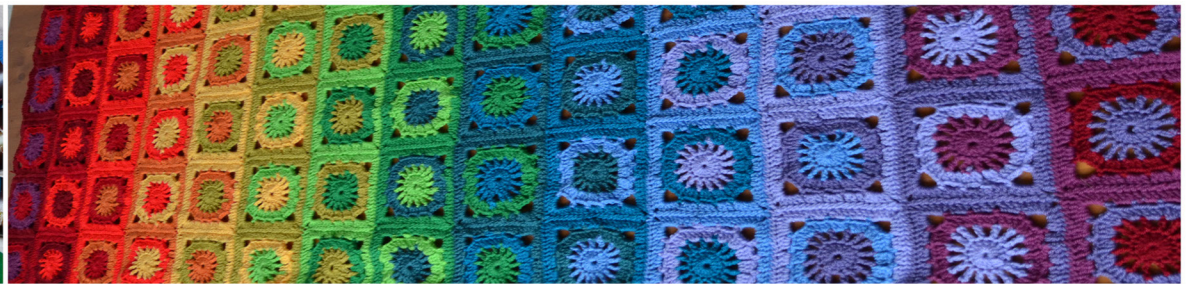

THE BORDER

COLOURS: 7 COLOURS YOU HAVE USED IN THE BLANKET OR 1 NEW BALL OF YARN IN THE COLOUR OF YOUR CHOICE.

SINCE THIS IS MY FIRST CAL DESIGN, I HADN'T FORSEEN THE DIFFERENCES IN GAUGE THAT PEOPLE ARE HAVING. SOME PEOPLE HAVE YARN LEFT, SOME OTHERS BARELY NONE. THAT'S WHY I RECOMMEND TO EVERYONE WHO THINKS THEY WILL NOT MAKE IT WITH THE YARN LEFT, TO USE A NEW BALL OF YARN WITH 1 COLOUR OF YOUR CHOICE (PREFERABLE A COLOUR YOU USED IN THE BLANKET). THE BLANKET IS QUITE HYSTERICAL AS IT IS WITH ALL THE RAINBOW COLOURS IN ALL THE GRANNY'S, SO DON'T BE AFRAID IT WON'T LOOK AWESOME IF YOU USE ONLY ONE COLOUR FOR THE BORDER ;).

USE THE SAME COLOUR FOR 7 ROWS OR CHANGE COLOUR AT THE BEGINNING OF EVERY ROW.



LAY THE BLANKET IN SUCH A WAY THAT YOU CAN START CROCHETING IN THE CORNER OF A RANDOM SQUARE. THIS SHOULD NOT BE THE CORNER OF THE BLANKET. WE ARE GOING TO CROCHET THE SAME PATTERN THE ENTIRE ROUND, EXCEPT FOR THE CORNERS OF THE BLANKET.

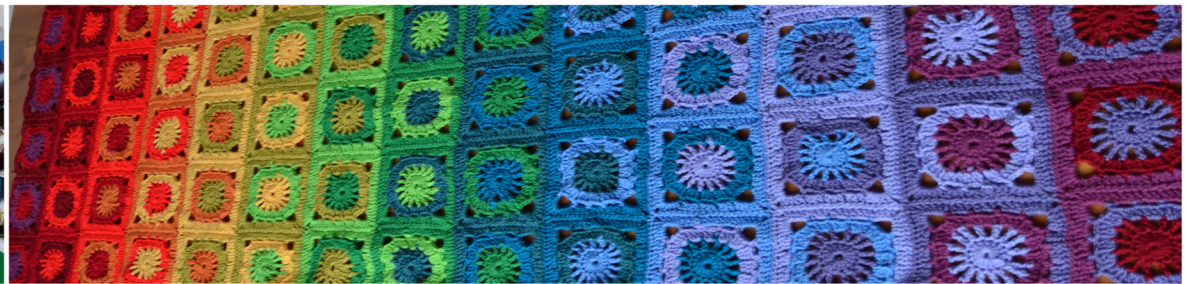
ROUND 1) CROCHET WITH THE FIRST COLOUR OF YOUR CHOICE (COLOUR USED IN EXAMPLE IS COLOUR 1) SC IN THE BACK LOOP OF THE STITCHES. WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE CORNER OF THE FIRST SQUARE, CROCHET 1SC IN THE CH2 AREA AND CONTINUE IN THE CORNER OF THE NEXT SQUARE WITH AGAIN 1SC IN CH2 AREA, AND SINGLE CROCHET IN BACK LOOPS. WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE CORNER OF THE BLANKET, CROCHET IN CH2 AREA: 2 SC, 2 CH, 2 SC. CONTINUE WITH SC IN BACK LOOPS. AT THE END OF THE ROUND, CROCHET WITH SL ST IN

FIRST STITCH OF THE ROUND.

ROUND 2) CHANGE COLOUR IF YOU WANT (COLOUR IN EXAMPLE IS COLOUR 4) AND SC IN EVERY STITCH UNTIL CORNER OF THE BLANKET. IN CH2 AREA OF CORNER: 1SC, 2CH, 1SC. AT THE END OF THE ROUND, CROCHET WITH SL ST IN FIRST STITCH OF THE ROUND.

ROUND 3) CHANGE COLOUR IF YOU WANT (COLOUR IN EXAMPLE IS COLOUR 5) AND REPEAT ROUND 2. AT THE END OF THE ROUND, CROCHET WITH SL ST IN FIRST STITCH OF THE ROUND.

ROUND 4) CHANGE COLOUR IF YOU WANT (COLOUR IN EXAMPLE IS COLOUR 7). CROCHET 1SC, 2CH, 1SC IN THE SAME STITCH. THIS FORMS A KIND OF 'V'SHAPE. SKIP 2 STITCHES AND CONTINUE UNTIL CORNER OF THE BLANKET.
